



The International Society for Cultural History (ISCH) is an academic society aiming at connecting and supporting cultural historians and their research from all over the world. The society was founded in 2008 and has since established itself as scholarly space for all things cultural history. The ISCH is dedicated to the interdisciplinary research of ‘cultural history’ in its most inclusive sense and is open to scholars from all continents and broadly from the fields of history and humanities.

The Society’s activities include:

- **The annual conference** with changing locations and themes, for students and more experienced scholars alike interested in cultural history.
- **The peer reviewed journal** *Cultural History*, published bi-annually with the Edinburgh University Press.
- **The publication series** *Studies for the International Society for Cultural History* with Routledge, for monographs and collections of articles in the field of cultural history.
- **The essay prize**, awarded each year to the best article on cultural history. The winning articles are also published in the Society’s journal *Cultural History*.

The annual membership fee (50/30€, 3- and 5-year memberships with discount) includes access to the Society’s electronic journal *Cultural History* with two new issues per year (April and October) as well as the possibility for conference participation. In addition, ISCH members receive a 20% discount on all EUP books, and a 10% discount on journal subscriptions.
