TOP 3 Reception of the treasurer's report

Liisa-Maija Korhonen, the treasurer of the ISCH, presents the financial report for 2024. The closing balance of the ISCH bank account and PayPal and Stripe accounts on 31 December 2024 was 12704,42€. In 2024, the net income was 2875,07€. A large part of this income has been used to support the Rovaniemi conference in 2025. The financial situation is stable.

TOP 4 Reception of the report of the editorial board of the society's journal

Chris Forth, the Editor-in-Chief of the Society's <u>journal Cultural History</u>, presents the journal and the possibilities to publish in it. Conference speakers are invited to propose their reworked conference papers to the journal. ISCH membership is not required to publish in *Cultural History*. The next two volumes are under preparation, and several special issues are under consideration.

TOP 5 Reception of any other reports esteemed necessary by the committee

- Publication series: Dana Weber, one of the two editors of the book series (<u>Studies for the International Society for Cultural History</u>, by Routledge), presents the possibility to publish in the series. At the moment, one monograph on ancient history has been accepted for publication. Other proposals are under review.
- ISCH conference 2026 in Paris: Laurent Martin, the organizer of the ISCH conference 2026 in Paris, presents the conference venue and theme. The next ISCH conference will be held in Paris on 10-12 September 2026. The theme of the conference is 'Identities, circulations, migrations a cultural history'. The venue will be Condorcet campus in Aubervilliers. Call for Papers and more information will be published during the autumn.
- Internet activity: Jasmin Lukkari, the secretary, presents <u>ISCH internet activity</u>. We publish ISCH related news such as conference CfP on our website, in our bi-annual newsletter, CULTHIST mailing list, on our Facebook page and on our Bluesky account which was recently created. Our X account still exists but will not be updated any longer.
